

PROTECTING DISASTER DISPLACED PERSONS THROUGH BETTER DATA AND KNOWLEDGE ON DISPLACEMENT RISKS

Comprehensive and systematic data collection on why, where, when, and how people move in the context of disasters is lacking, particularly when people cross international borders. Data collection and reporting on disaster displacement and human mobility must be improved and inform national and regional DRR strategies and practice. The panel will gather representatives from the Philippine Government, the Coordination Center for the Prevention of Natural Disasters in Central America (CEPREDENAC), Internal Displacement Monitoring Centre (IDMC) and the International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies (IFRC) who will share effective practices on addressing disaster displacement. Discussions will be chaired by Germany and moderated by Alan Lavell.
