## **COMPREHENSIVE APPROACHES TO ADDRESS CLIMATE RISKS AND HUMAN MOBILITY RELATED TO THE ADVERSE EFFECTS OF CLIMATE CHANGE: THE CASE OF BANGLADESH**

Primarily the poor and vulnerable are exposed to the adverse effects of climate change. Many are “trapped”, while others leave their homes. To protect those most at risk, humanitarian and development actors as well as governments need to become more pro-active risk managers and adopt comprehensive approaches.

This side event will bring together different approaches to climate and disaster risks from a human mobility perspective, share experience from Bangladesh and examples of Germany’s international engagement to reduce the humanitarian impacts of extreme weather events, integrate risk financing solutions, address the drivers and consequences of displacement and support the most vulnerable to adapt to the effects of climate change.

Speakers include government representatives and experts from the World Bank, the GIZ and the German Red Cross.
