For the first time in the history of United Nations' climate negotiations, Loss and Damage (L&D) finance is part of the official agenda of the conference of the parties (COP27) at Sharm El-Sheikh in Egypt. In an effort to strengthen action to avert, minimize and address L&D in vulnerable developing countries, Member States are at a pivotal moment to define their commitments.
